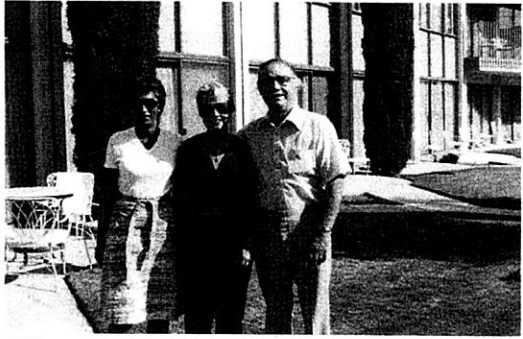
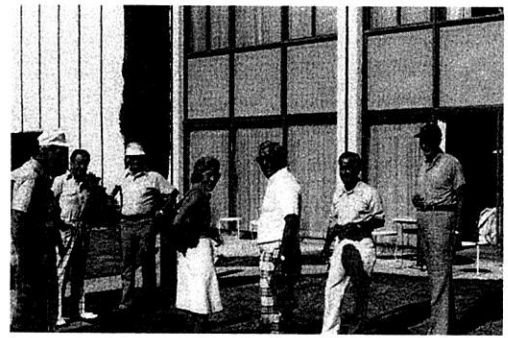
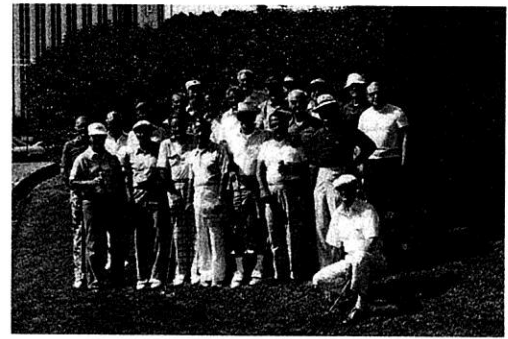
We've been having these reunions since 1965. We've had a lot of fun organizing and financing them. However, some of the Satan's Angels have never acknowledged these efforts in any manner.
